It holds the record for the largest frame in the world. The building has a height of 150.24 meters and a width of 95.53 meters. The UAE's latest cultural landmark, Dubai Frame is an iconic structure that 'frames' impressive views of Old and New Dubai, while serving as a metaphorical bridge connecting the emirate's rich past with its magnificent present. Then enjoy your Lunch @ Rangoli Restaurant. Later, proceed to Miracle Garden. Dubai is Miracle Garden (ticket included). Dubai Miracle Garden is the world's largest natural flower garden, home to 150 million flowers of different varieties and is among the top tourist place. Each season, as the weather begins to cool at the onset of winter, the gates reopen at Dubai Miracle Garden. With more than 150 million flowers in full bloom, this 72,000-sq-m paradise has flowered into one of the region's most picturesque, sweet-scented destinations for more than a decade now. Dubai Miracle Garden is only open for a limited time during the winter months in UAE. If you really wish to visit the garden, plan your trip to UAE between November and March to see the flowers in full bloom. Then proceed to visit Global Village (tickets included). Welcome to a world where 90 cultures come together, where new and exciting can be found around every corner, where colours, flavours and experiences blends. Global Village Dubai, a renowned hub blending cultural, entertainment, and shopping experiences from around the globe, is open from October 18, 2023, to April 28, 2024. The park timing is from Saturday to Wednesday from 4:00 pm-12:00 am and usually gates close at 11:30pm but park remains open for late-night during public holidays, Thursday, and Friday from 4:00 pm -1:00 am and entry gates close at 12:30 am. At the end of the day you will drop at Indian Restaurant for dinner @ Bombay Bites. Later, back to the hotel. Overnight stay at Dubai Hotel.

20 NOV 2024 – DAY 04: This morning after early breakfast proceed to Abu Dhabi. You will be picked up from Hotel Lobby. On arrival visit BAPS Hindu Temple. The BAPS Hindu Mandir Abu Dhabi in the UAE, is a traditional Hindu mandir built by the BAPS Swaminarayan Sanstha. Inspired by Pramukh Swami Maharaj and consecrated by Mahant Swami Maharaj on 14 February 2024, this is the first traditional Hindu mandir in Abu Dhabi. Later, proceed to enjoy your Lunch @ India By Nature restaurant. Then Abu Dhabi City Tour . Abu Dhabi and visit Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque – this architectural work of art is one of the world's largest mosques, with a capacity for an astonishing 41,000 worshipers. The ultimate family entertainment destination. AT the end of the day you will enjoy your dinner @ Kathiyawadi restaurant. Later, back to the hotel. Overnight stay at Dubai Hotel.

21 NOV 2024 – DAY 05: This morning after breakfast check out the hotel and proceed to visit Meena Bazar & Gold Souk Market. One of the most buzzworthy places to visit in Dubai is the textile market. Meena Bazar or the Cosmos Lane that is located near Khalid Bin Waleed Street gives you an option of
